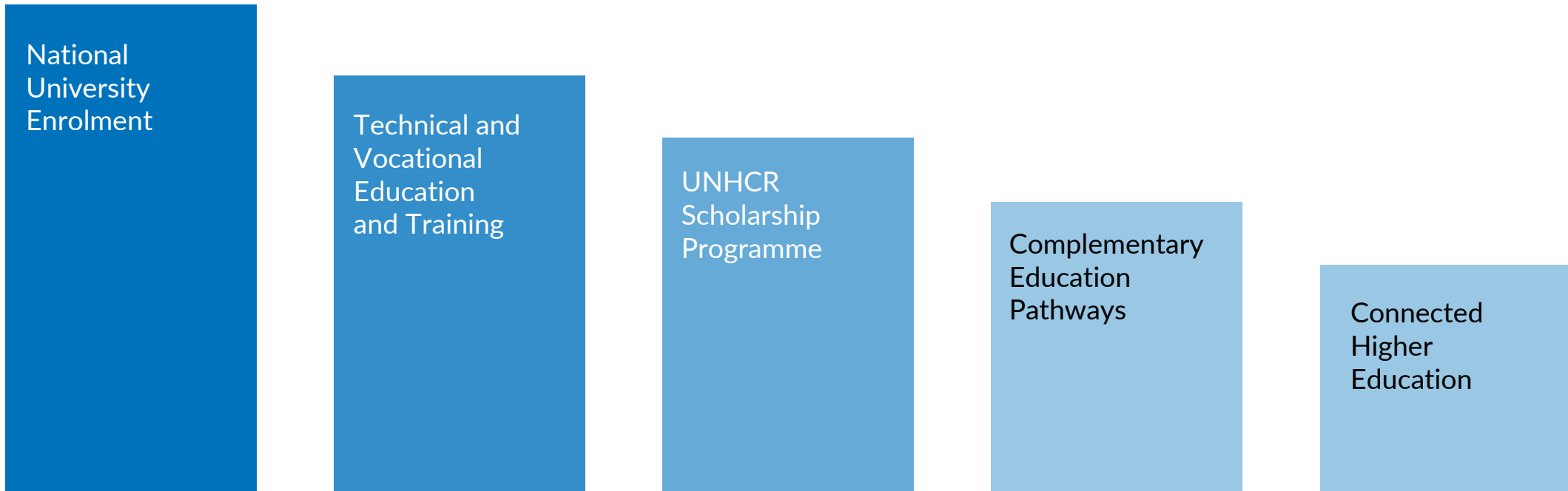

Population and Protection Environment

Signatory to the 1951 Refugee Convention and 1967 Protocol

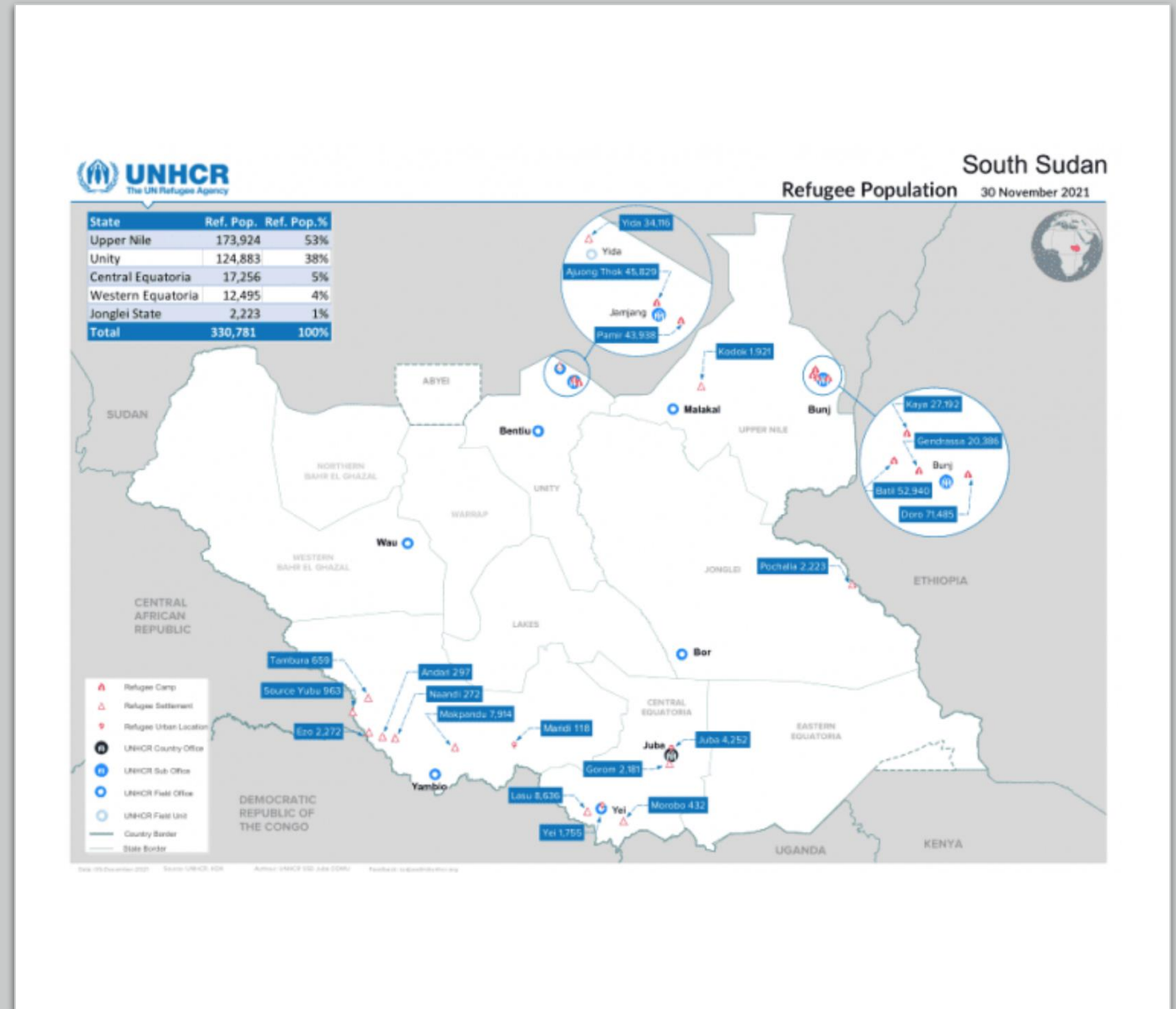
330,000 refugees and asylum-seekers

2 million internally displaced persons, due to conflict, insecurity and the impact of climate change

Over 500,000 returnees since the signing of the Peace Agreement in 2018

Refugee education is aligned to the national system and curriculum; however, refugees pay international student fees for higher education

Right to work for refugees





Education Situation Analysis

- UNHCR operates all schools in the camps with support of NGO partners (LWF, IRC, DRC). Double shift schooling is in place at all levels.
- Opportunities for tertiary education are limited to DAFI programme, demand is high, expansion necessary.
- 7 universities in South Sudan
- Only 10 of 26 TVET centres operational nationwide

National Enrolment

- Teacher capacity development
- DAFI alumni certified to teach basic ed
- MOUs with HEI to leverage placements for refugee youth

UNHCR Scholarship Programme

- Increase female enrolment
- Innovative pathways where access is limited
- Amplify student-led advocacy
- Fundraising

TVET

- Advocate for accreditation and quality assurance process for TVET centres
- Market research to identify market aligned skills
- Infrastructure improvement

Complementary Education Pathways

- Turkish Bursary scholarship
- Peer to peer university advising, access to information

Connected Higher Education

- Expand connected learning in settlement areas
- Close collaboration with INS in the located settlements
- Connected Learning in Crisis Consortium opportunities
