Project Presentation

The Egmont Institute is an independent research and training centre based in Brussels, with 3 research programmes and 1 Education & Training programme.

The involvement of Egmont in the higher education sector in Africa started in 2014 with a partnership with the National School for Administration (*Ecole Nationale d'Administration* – ENA) in the Democratic Republic of Congo.

Our project believes in the future generation of civil servants, educated and trained within resilient structures which meet the needs of their own administrations.

We insist on supporting such schools and institutes which have a clear mandate to train the future administrative elite, who then integrate the administration at management level.

Since the onset of this project, the scope of our activities has expanded to encompass more aspects of public administration, and more countries (Mali; current prospection in other priority countries for Belgian cooperation).

Our approach for ongoing and future partnerships is based on:

- ✓ Cooperation with resilient structures that contribute to the strengthening of their countries' administration;
- ✓ Peer-to-peer learning with the involvement of EU public servants in the training sessions, creating interesting networks;
- ✓ Follow-up of the progress and integration of public servants in their administration.

CONCRETE RESULTS

- ✓ 453 trainee-civil servants from ENA DRC trained since 2014 and 45 trainee-civil servants from ENA Mali trained in 2019
- ✓ 65 training modules designed and offered to the partner schools
- ✓ Large network of trainers & experts created in Brussels and in-country (Belgian administration, Belgian development agency, EU delegations, academics & experts)
- ✓ 39 professional traineeships organised in Brussels for future Congolese and Malian civil servants

LONG-TERM RESULTS

- ✓ **Sustainability** of the schools and improvement of the curricula
- ✓ Sharing visions between European and African administrations and encouraging the mutualisation of expertise
- ✓ **Involving talented young generations** in the future of their country through their integration in public service
- ✓ Contribution to the objectives of administration reform and good governance
