

- More than 4800 young men and women trained as professional farmers and fishermen
- More than 3000 young men and women settled as farmers
- More than 2300 youths trained in agricultural entrepreneurship, extension, and other related jobs (technical high school diploma)
- An estimated 6000 jobs created in rural areas
- 122 agricultural vocational training centers and schools (public and private) renovated all over the country, with all the needed staff (see map
- Around 700 trainers, teachers, educational inspectors, managers & support staff animating the learning system, from central to local level
